

Packing List

FROM INSIGHTS TO IMPACT - PALM SPRINGS RETREAT, DANICA BUNCH

When packing for Bali, prioritise lightweight, breathable fabrics that will keep you cool and comfortable in the tropical climate. Opt for versatile pieces that can be mixed and matched to create different outfits throughout your trip. This is a suggested packing list, so feel free to adjust it based on your personal preferences.

Tops

- Lightweight t-shirts and tops (for workshops, excursions, and casual wear)
- Long-sleeve shirts (for sun protection during Joshua Tree and cooler evenings)
- Smart-casual tops or collared shirts (for group dinners and networking)

Bottoms

- Lightweight trousers or pants (ideal for workshops, dinners, and desert excursions)
- Casual shorts (for downtime or warm days)
- Jeans or heavier trousers (for cooler evenings)
- Skirts or dresses (optional for dinners or leisure)

Outerwear

- Light to medium-weight jacket or jumper (desert evenings can be cool)
- Lightweight rain jacket or compact travel umbrella (in case of unexpected showers)
- Sun hat or wide-brimmed hat (for sun protection during outdoor activities)

Undergarments

- Underwear for the duration of the trip
- Bras (including a sports bra)
- Socks (lightweight for everyday wear, plus hiking socks for Joshua Tree)

Shoes

- Comfortable walking shoes or lightweight hiking shoes (for Joshua Tree National Park)
- Sneakers or closed-toe shoes (for casual activities)
- Dress shoes, loafers, or smart sandals (for dinners)

Sleepwear

- Pyjamas or lightweight sleepwear

Accessories

- Sunglasses (UV protection for desert sun)
- Lightweight scarf (optional for style or warmth in the evening)
- Belt (if needed)
- Minimal jewellery (avoid valuables)
- Day bag or backpack (for excursions)
- Reusable water bottle
- Travel adapter (Type C Type A/B for U.S. outlets)
- Portable fan or cooling towel (optional, for warm days outdoors)

Work Session Essentials

- Laptop or tablet (for workshops and strategy sessions)
- Chargers for all devices and/or portable power bank
- Notepad or journal with pens/highlighters
- USB drive or external storage (optional)

Other

- Passport and travel documents (if coming from outside the U.S.)
- Travel insurance details
- Cash and/or credit cards
- Medications (including for common travel issues like motion sickness or allergies)
- Personal hygiene items and toiletries (including sunscreen and lip balm with SPF)
- Basic first-aid kit (pain relief, plasters, antiseptic wipes)
- Ziplock bags (for organising items or storing snacks during excursions)
